Taking into account HxA's varied membership, we ask that members keep in mind that they will be speaking to a general audience and that the concepts discussed in these conversations be presented in a way that is accessible to someone without prior knowledge. Conversations can have lecture or presentation-style components, though a portion of the allotted time must also be used for group conversation or Q&A.
